Doors open at 6:30 for this meeting so get there early to bring your auction items and see what's available!

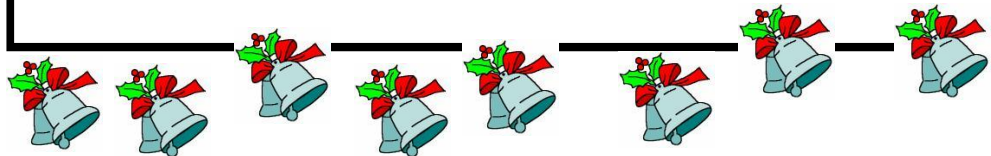
